Pete Pin is a documentary photographer who was born in a refugee camp after the Cambodian genocide and immigrated to California in the mid 1980's.

Drawing from the experiences of his family as survivors of the Khmer Rouge regime (1975-1979), Pete Pin photographs Cambodian communities throughout the United States. He documents the struggle and pain of the survivors and the direct descendants of the genocide that took millions of lives. The series is a testament to those who died, and an examination of where future generations are now. In an attempt to understand his heritage, Pin pays tribute to the lives of the survivors.

Pin received his BA at the University of California at Berkeley where he graduated magna cum laude in Political Science with high departmental honors. He was the 2011 Fellow at the Magnum Foundation Emergency Fund and was named an Emerging Talent by Getty Reportage.
